An Overview of Requirements Elicitation > Business Analyst

Requirements elicitation interviews are often used as starting point of the requirements elicitation process [1, 2, 3, 4]. Interviews are often perceived by students and novice analysts as an easy tool to use, but they can be affected by several factors, that can prevent the analyst to elicit all the relevant knowledge – including tacit knowledge – during the elicitation process.

Requirements Elicitation for Business Analysts: Interviews

Requirements elicitation is the first activity in the requirements engineering process. It includes learning, surfacing, and discovering the requirements of the stakeholders of the developed system. Various elicitation techniques exist to help analysts elicit the requirements from the different stakeholders; the most commonly used technique is the interview.

The role of domain knowledge in requirements elicitation

Interviews: A typical conversational method is interviews. It is most commonly used method in requirements elicitation. An Interview is generally conducted by an experienced analyst, who has some generic knowledge about the application domain as well.
